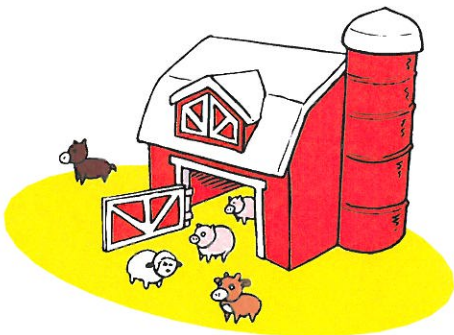

# Important Information

There will be a special kick-off registration Sunday May 31st, from 4-6 pm! If you miss this registration time you can register from June 1– June 12 on business days 8-5 pm. All registration takes place at the Nash County Ag Center.



The camps fill up very quickly and are on a **FIRST COME AND SIGN UP** basis, don't delay registering!



Children should be dropped off and picked up at the designated areas **ON TIME**.



Please sign in and sign out when you pick up and drop off your child.



If the child is 5, we expect the child to have already completed **KINDERGARTEN** before date of participation. Our programs are not designed for five year olds who are in preschool or have not attended kindergarten.



Make sure to **READ** and **FOLLOW** the special instructions for each individual camp.



Make sure your child reads and understands the 4-H Code of Conduct about appropriate behavior, attire, language, and respecting others.



Only accepting cash, check or money order. **NO CREDIT CARDS**. Make checks payable to Nash County 4-H. Payment **REQUIRED** at time of registration. Returned checks will have a fee of \$30.



All fees are **non-refundable** unless the class is canceled. Some classes require a minimum number of participants. If the 4-H office cancels an event, a refund will be given.



If you are unable to attend a camp after registering, please let us know so that other children may have the opportunity to participate.



If you have any crafts your child makes at a camp or at home, we would be happy to enter it in the State Fair.



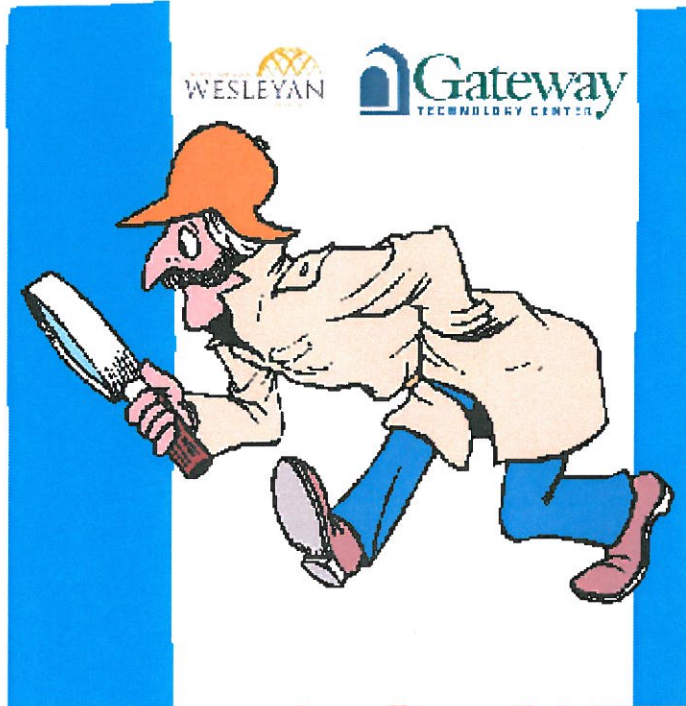

# Directions to 4-H Summer Camps

Please call the 4-H Office at (252) 459-9810, with any questions.

Most 4-H summer camps and workshops will be held at the Agricultural Center in Nashville; however, the following will be held at other locations. Directions for each are as follows:

## Nash Community College

From Ag Center, turn left on Eastern Avenue. Proceed to traffic light and turn left. Take a slight right to merge onto US-64 E for 2 miles. Then take exit 463 toward Red Oak. Then take a right onto N Old Carriage Rd and Nash Community College will be on the right.



## HORSE CAMPS at Circle J Farm—2736 Reges Store Road in Nashville

From Ag Center, turn left on Eastern Avenue. Proceed to traffic light and turn left on Red Oak Road. Proceed to Reges Store Road (at L & L), and turn right. Circle J Farm will be on left. Pasture in front and green mailbox.



## MEDICAL ACADEMY—Nash General Hospital in Rocky Mount

Take 64-E towards Rocky Mount. Exit on Winstead Avenue and turn right. Hospital will be on the right. Follow road back to main hospital. Meet in hospital lobby on first day.



## CRIMINAL JUSTICE CAMP—Nash County Sheriff's Dept. in Nashville

As you leave the Ag Center, turn right on Eastern Avenue and proceed towards downtown Nashville. Turn right just past courthouse and park in public parking lot on right. Sheriff's Dept. is in the Juvenile Detention center behind the courthouse. Enter at top of steps and proceed down hall to Sheriff's Office.



## AG SAFETY DAY- East Carolina Ag and Education Center

Take 64 E towards Rocky Mount. Take exit 478 on Kingsboro Road and turn right. The arena will be on your left less than a mile down the road.
