Eligibility:

To be eligible for the “Show it Forward” Scholarship, participants must be between the ages of 8-18 as of January 1, 2022, and be enrolled in 4-H Online and registered for the 2022 East Carolina 4-H Livestock Show and Sale.

“Show it Forward” Participant Program Rules and Regulations

1. Participants must be between the ages of 8 – 18, as of January 1, 2022, and reside or participate in Nash county. Participants are recruited through correspondence, local 4-H clubs, and local media.
2. Participants will receive \$500 to support their 4-H Livestock Project (steer, lamb, goat, or hog) for the 2022 East Carolina 4-H Livestock Show and Sale. The participants may use this funding at their own discretion - whether it is to purchase an animal, feed, or equipment.
3. Participants will raise the project to maturity (or until the East Carolina 4-H Livestock Show and Sale) under the supervision of the guardians and Extension Agents.
4. Participants will be responsible for all expenses incurred while raising them (feed, medication, facility, etc.).
5. Participants will weigh in 1 steer on Monday, December 6th or 1 lamb, goat, OR hog on Monday, January 31, 2022, and show said animal at the East Carolina 4-H Livestock Show and Sale on April 5-6, 2022 at the East Carolina Agriculture and Education Center, 1175 Kingsboro Rd, Rocky Mount, NC.
6. If participants **DO NOT** exhibit their project in the East Carolina 4-H Livestock Show and Sale, they will pay a **recovery fee of \$500**. The *only* exception to this is in the event of a confirmed disaster**. *If you have a qualifying disaster, you **must** contact the Nash County Cooperative Extension Office immediately (within 24 hours) so they may verify the situation and/or provide photographic evidence.*
 - **Examples of confirmed disasters include but are not limited to: predator kills, diseases, extreme weather
7. Participants are responsible for contacting local companies and businesses to raise support and contributions for their 4-H Livestock Projects. Participants will turn in contributions in accordance with Nash County’s collection policies.
8. Pay it forward! To support next year’s “Show it Forward” Scholarship Recipients, participants are asked to raise a minimum of \$500 to reimburse the scholarship program. Any funds raised above \$500 will be given to the participants after their project record books are completed and meet the required deadline
