An absentee farmer may designate only one market-certified vendor to sell his/her agricultural items at the market, provided those items are grown or produced in North Carolina. Vendors must be the original producer of at least 70% of items being sold April-August. Starting the first market day in September, vendors will be allowed to follow a 50/50 rule. Vendors must adhere to strict rules outlined in the market guidelines when selling an absentee vendor's product.
