****You will NOT be able to add classes at the show. Please sign up for All Classes you intend to show at the time you register! This is in keeping with the State 4-H Horse Show Policy.**

Measurement staff must measure all ponies in Junior & Senior Hunter classes before the show packet can be picked up.

Coggins

COGGINS WILL BE CHECKED WHILE ON SHOWGROUNDS. (Must present a paper copy at check in!)

Eligibility Cards:

Must be completed and signed by EXTENSION AGENT for every horse/rider combination. Only submit a **COPY**, you must keep your original.

Stalls: First come, first serve availability. No tack stalls. Supply your own shavings or contact Travis Alford (252-450-5438) for pre-ordered shavings delivery. Strip stalls before leaving. We encourage hauling in for the day.

Important Reminders:

- *All riders must wear an ASTM approved helmet when mounted.*
- *No cell phone use when mounted.*
- *All western riders must show with a number displayed on each side of their saddle pad with the exception of the gaming division.*
- *The trail classes will run open card from 11am-2pm on Saturday, May 4. You will let the ring steward know which class you are riding in.*

INFORMATION & RULES

1. Neither the North Carolina Cooperative Extension Service, Northeast District 4-H, Southeast District 4-H, or show hosts will be responsible for an accident that may occur to any animal, person, or property at this show. The exhibitors and spectators shall hold the management or owners or grounds as a hold harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceeding arising from any accident that might occur.
2. The judges' decision shall be final. When an exhibitor or exhibitor's parents, leader, or agent is guilty of unsportsmanlike conduct, the show management may suspend such exhibitor's rights to participate in future classes and/or shows for such a period of time as judged appropriate.
3. Rules from the North Carolina 4-H Horse Program Rules and Regulations Manual will be followed. USEF, AQHA, AMHR, USDF, WDAA, and WHOA rules will be followed for their respective divisions not covered in the NC 4-H Horse Program Rules and Regulations Manual.
4. Show management reserves the right to (a) combine, cancel or split classes depending on the number of entries and (b) disqualify from showing any horse or pony that is unmanageable, dangerous, or unsound and any youth who exhibits unsportsmanlike or inappropriate behavior.
5. **Exhibitors will not be allowed to add classes at the show.**
6. **Cloverbuds:** are defined as youth ages 5-7 as of January 1st of the current year. Cloverbud classes are non-competitive with no entry fee.
7. **Short Stirrup:** Riders must be ages 8-13 as of January 1st of the current year. Three years' participation in the division is allowed, with no more than 2 years' showing over fences. (Hunter Hack does not count towards the 2 years over fences and may be shown all 3 years.
8. **Rookie:** Riders in their first year of showing Hunt Seat as a Junior or Senior as of January 1st of the current year. Riders are permitted 1 year to show at this level.
9. **Long Stirrup:** Riders must be ages 14-18 as of January 1st of the current year. Two years of participation in the division is allowed. Riders in this division may not have previously shown over fences for more than 2 years.
10. **Little Britches:** Riders must be ages 8-13 as of January 1st of the current year, who are in their first 2 years of showing. Riders in this division cannot cross enter in the Junior Western or Junior Ranch Divisions.
11. **Junior Riders:** Youth who are ages 8-13 as of January 1st of the current year.
12. **Senior Riders:** Youth who are 14-18 as of January 1st of the current year and have not reached the age of 19 as of January 1st of the current year.
13. The judge will place all classes through 10th place. However, the show will only give 1st-6th place ribbons.
14. Cross Rail Working Hunter Over Fences is a non-point class that is open to Juniors and Seniors, horses and ponies. Riders in this class may not cross-enter into any other working hunter or equitation over fences class. This class will be an introductory working hunter class to be performed at the canter over 18" cross rail fences only.

Qualifying Points: The following point system will be used in earning qualifying points toward attending the State 4-H Horse Show. Each exhibitor and horse must earn one or more qualifying points in each division to be eligible to participate in that division in the State Show. The number of horses in a class will be determined by the number shown. Under no circumstances shall a disqualified contestant receive points; however, each horse brought into the ring will constitute an entry and will be counted.

LIABILITY WAIVER, ASSUMPTION OF THE RISK, PHOTO RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

In consideration for being allowed by NC State to participate, which includes but is not limited to being an active participant or spectator, in the 4-H Horse Show Program (hereinafter "Program") the undersigned custodial parent/guardian agrees as follows:

I accept and assume responsibility for all risks, known and unknown, involved to me and/or my child and my and/or their property in the aforementioned activity, and I voluntarily authorize my and/or my child's participation in reliance upon my own judgment and knowledge of my and/or child's experience and capabilities.

I understand that the determination of my child's ability to participate in the Program should be made by my child's physician if necessary, including being found by such physician to be in good health and fully able to perform all activities associated with the Program. I understand that I need the approval of a physician if I am uncertain as to his/her physical fitness for the rigors of this Program. I understand that I may be required to seek approval from a physician if there is a health or safety question relative to my child's condition before being allowed to participate in the Program. In addition, I give permission to any doctor, hospital, or other medical facility to release confidentially to the treating physician(s) for my child any information they may have concerning my medical condition(s) and their professional contact with him/her for treatment purposes. I hereby grant my permission for such diagnostic, therapeutic, and operative procedures as deemed necessary for my child's benefit. A photocopy of this permission is to be considered valid as the original. I further understand that treatment for any medical problems my child may suffer is my responsibility and will be paid by me and/or covered by my insurance.

**BILLY S. MURRAY, SR. 4-H HORSE PROGRAM
SCHOLARSHIP**



BACKGROUND: Billy S. Murray, Sr. was a professional farrier and a long time 4-H leader and supporter in the Southeast District. Billy led 4-H horse clubs in both New Hanover and Brunswick counties. He was also an active member of several horse organizations in Southeastern NC, including the Carolina Classic Horsemen's Association, the Seagate Saddle Club, the Brunswick County and Columbus County Horsemen's Association. He was always willing to lend a hand and help out other horse owners and youth in a time of need. His sudden death came in September of 2005, after volunteering his time to announce an annual horse show in Wayne County. This scholarship was established to carry on Billy's tradition of supporting youth through 4-H horse activities.

PURPOSE: To assist high school seniors and graduates who are continuing their education by pursuing a two or four year college degree, and have been active 4-H members and participants of the Southeast or Northeast District 4-H Horse Program.

AWARD: A \$500 scholarship to one high school senior or graduate enrolling at a senior or community college. The award will be mailed directly to the college.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Recipients will be selected based on the following criteria:

- 30% scholastic achievement
- 35% 4-H horse activities and involvement
- 35% 4-H non-horse activities and involvement

APPLICANT RULES:

1. Applicants must be a high school senior or graduate and a resident of the Southeast or Northeast 4-H District.
2. Applicants must have been active in 4-H and SE/NE District 4-H horse activities.
3. The entire application form must be completed.
4. Grade transcripts must be included with the application material.
5. Applicants must provide two personal reference **contacts**, one from their school staff, one a community leader. Letters of reference are not required. Homeschooled youth may provide two community leader references.
6. Selected recipient will be recognized at the East Regional 4-H Qualifying Horse Show, in Williamston, NC.
