4-H Livestock Show and Sale Memorial Scholarship

Objective

To recognize and provide financial assistance to a graduating 4-H senior who has been involved in the livestock program and plan to continue their education beyond high school.

Regulations and Stipulations

- 1. Awarded to a high school graduating Nash, Edgecombe or Halifax 4-H Program Livestock Participant. Only eligible during their Senior Graduating Year.
- 2. To be eligible, graduating seniors must submit the completed application prior to 5:00pm on Monday, April 1, 2024. No late applications will be accepted. Bring to Livestock Arena during weigh-in.
- 3. It is not necessary to attend a four-year college or university to be eligible but enrollment in a formal continuing education program is required.
- 4. 4-H'ers must have been enrolled in a 4-H livestock project to be eligible.
- 5. A 500 word or less essay on "The Benefits of Participating in the 4-H Livestock Project."
- 6. This award will be given jointly to the individual and their chosen institution of higher learning. This is not a cash award.
- 7. Three letters of recommendation and a high school transcript must be submitted attached to the scholarship application.
- 8. The recipient(s) will be recognized at the time of the Senior Recognition just before the sale of the livestock projects.
