FDA Joint Cleaning and Sanitation Workshop

Workshop Description: The Cleaning and Sanitation Workshop aims to promote greater understanding of cleaning and sanitation practices that can be implemented on and around the farm to meet, and potentially exceed, the requirements of the Produce Safety Rule. While the primary focus is under Subpart L: Equipment, Tools, Buildings, and Sanitation and under Subpart K: Growing, Harvesting, Packing, and Holding Activities ; Subpart A: General Provisions will also be reviewed. This workshop is designed to be interactive using presentations that encourage discussions, scenario-based small group breakouts, hands-on activities, and in-person demonstrations. The workshop is structured to accommodate regional considerations within the content.
