Requirements for 2024-2025



Youth must complete 4-H online registration to participate in the Edgecombe County 4-H Livestock Show Program in 2024 & must re-enroll in January 2025.

Youth must complete the livestock show registration by the deadline. This will be a google form that we use for everything involved with the show & sale

4-H Membership Requirement

Show Registration Requirement



Youth must complete a minimum of 5 credits to participate. Credits must be entered in the form before the deadline! List of eligible points will be provided.

Youth must complete a 4-H Project Record Book (Project Book, Animal Record Form & a Copy of a Thank You Note to Buyers). Incomplete books will not be accepted! Must have a hard copy of the book turned in for judging-not emailed.

5 Program Credits Required

4-H Project Record Book & Workshop Required

Youth must attend 1 of the Arena Clean-ups (2 dates available).

Arena Clean-Up

Youth will submit credits via online form as they complete the approved activity. Deadline to submit completed contract credits via Google Form is March 14th.

Livestock Educational Activities:

Attend Livestock Orientation on October 28 @ 6pm or make an appointment to review & establish your livestock contract prior to the registration deadline dependent upon species.

Attend 4-H Achievement Program: February 2025

Attend 4-H Club Meetings (1 credit per educational club meeting). Club leaders will send rosters to the 4-H office for attendance verification.

Youth must attend a 4-H Project Record Book Workshop to help in completing the project book requirement.

Youth may support a 4-H Community Service Project; December- Ronald McDonald House Charities/Children's Hospital; February: 'Hungry to Help' Food Donations for local pantry; March: "Pound the Arena"

Youth may attend Livestock School, East Coast Extravaganza; Blue & Gold Show; other livestock jackpot shows for 1 credit each show.

Please check with 4-H staff regarding eligibility of a program prior to attendance to make sure you receive credit.

Participant & Parent/Guardian must review & approve via online registration to complete the requirements to participate in the program. Extension staff are authorized to prohibit participation in the show & sale if participant fails to complete the stated contract items.



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
